Town of Clarksville ADA Non-Discrimination Policy

The Town of Clarksville is committed to promoting the quality of opportunity for all citizens. The Town takes pride in ensuring that people with disabilities are able to take part in, and benefit from, the range of public programs, services, and activities offered by the Town. The Town continues to modify its facilities, programs, policies, or practices, as necessary, to ensure access is provided. The Town does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, age, religion, creed or disability in admission to, access to, or operations of its programs, services, or activities. Discrimination against any person in recruitment, examination, appointment, training, promotion, retention, discipline or any other employment practices because of non-merit factors shall be prohibited.

People with disabilities also have the right to be accompanied by service animals in public areas throughout the Town of Clarksville under the Americans with Disabilities Act, and interference with or denial of this right may also be a violation of law. Service animals play an important role in ensuring the independence of people with disabilities, and it is therefore our policy to welcome into our Town any animal that is individually trained to assist a person with a disability.
